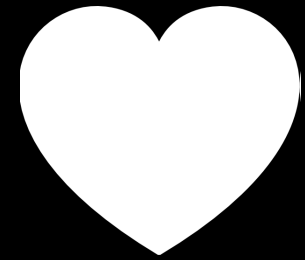
A. Our Hope : In Jesus Christ

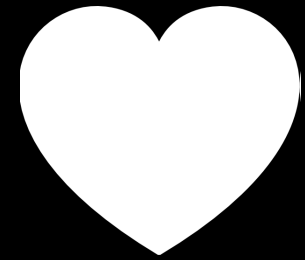


- The Motivation: God is holy (vv.1-4)

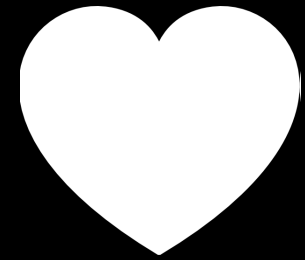

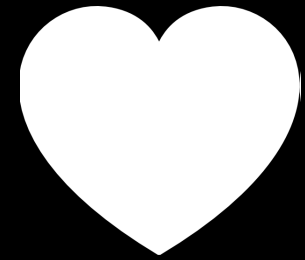

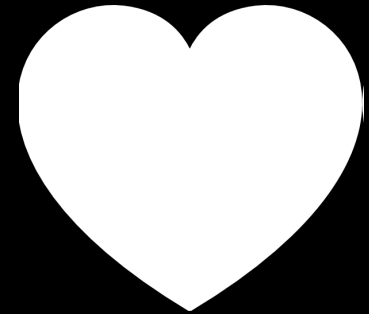
A. Our Hope: In Jesus Christ
