


 - b. I regard others and their gifts as equally essential compared to myself. (21-26).

1 Cor 12:15-16

If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

Myth 1 –

I can be disconnected from the local body of believers.

1 Cor 12:18

But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

Myth 2 –

We do not need another believer or his gifts.

1 Cor 12:21

And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

1 Cor 12: 25-26

That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

"in particular" = according to own place and function.
