



Answer: I believe so. 2 Sam 12. Heaven will reflect the glory of God's mercy and saving grace.

Answer: God can and will reveal Christ to those who sincerely seek God. Heaven will reflect the glory of God's mercy and saving grace.

Psalm 90:2,4

Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God... For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night.



Rev. 21: 4.

And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Questions received -

What age will we be when we get to heaven? Will we stay that age forever?

Answer: The Bible does not indicate specific ages. Time passes differently in heaven. The effects of earthly aging i.e. pain and death will not be there. Heaven will reflect the glory of God's eternal perfection.

Will I recognize you in Heaven?

Because God is infinitely creative, our resurrected bodies will be:

different from our earthly bodies (vv.35-44)
 like Christ's resurrected body (vv.45-49)

There will be new heaven and new earth

Rev 21:1

"And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea."

2 Cor 12:2ff

I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven. And I knew such a man, (whether in the body, or out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;)...

2 Cor 12:2ff

How that he was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter. Of such an one will I glory: yet of myself I will not glory, but in mine infirmities...

Answer:

There will be a new heaven and new earth. The present heaven (1st heaven) is therefore known by some as the intermediate state. Bible gives examples of pp who have gone to heaven and they are fully recognizable in bodily form, although they have not received their final resurrected bodies.

Answer: The Bible records glimpses of heaven. We should rely on the Biblical data as the basis of our beliefs.
