Parable of the Talents: Lesson







Parables

- Stories with a lesson
- Not meant for 1:1 literal application to real life

Find the main theme/lesson illustrated.



Emphasis – achieving master's purpose.

- Parable had a commercial setting.
- Aim in parable was for servants to make money for master, which was the master's purpose in that context.



Emphasis – achieving master's purpose.

- Good Servants
 - Emphasis on return on investment.
 - Commended for achieving that purpose.



Bad Servant

- Knew master's purpose
- "Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed" (v.24)





Bad Servant

Master: You knew the purpose – you ought to have at least got a return of monetary interest!

Because difficulties show us that God is still in control.


