"Come & See"

John 1:35-51

- John the Baptist pointed disciples to the Lord
- Andrew pointed Simon to the Lord
- Philip was pointed to the Lord
- Philip pointed Nathanael to the Lord

It's not about "I", but it's about "Him".

JOHN 1

- In the beginning was the Word, the Word was with God, the Word was God.
- All things were made by HIM, without HIM was not anything made that was made.
- In HIM was life, and the life was the light of man.
- (John the Baptist) came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through HIM might believe.
- That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.
- HE was in the world, and the world was made by HIM, and the world knew HIM not.
- HE came unto HIS own, and HIS own received HIM not. But as many as received HIM, to them gave HE power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on HIS name:
