First of All – Pray!

- Pray when you are fearful and don't know what to do!
- 2 Chronicles 20:3 ***And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. 4 And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask help of the LORD: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.***

King Jehoshaphat's prayer

- 2 Chronicles 20:12 [ESV]

O our God, will you not execute judgment on them? For we are powerless against this great horde (multitude) that is coming against us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you."

2. Pray! Take time to pray

- James 4:2 “...yet ye have not, because ye ask not.”
- *James 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.*

3. Pray! God's will be done!

Jesus' Prayer at Gethsemane

- **Mark 14: 36“...nevertheless not what I will , but what thou wilt.”**
- **Luke 22: 42 Saying , Father, if thou be willing , remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done .**
