▪ Mark 7:20-23

That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

All these evil things come from within, and defile the man..

And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.

- Mark 7:3-4

For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.

- Mark 7:3-4

... And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables.

Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free.

And ye suffer him no more to do ought for his father or his mother;

Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

▪ Mark 7:14-15

... There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man.

▪ Mark 7:18-19

... Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

- Matthew 6:22-23

... The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

ESV: The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light,...
