For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

EXAMPLES

- You shall dress in a suit and tie every Sunday, especially if you are a Pastor (or Pastors' children)
- You shall not eat meat on some days, especially near special Christian memorial days
- You shall only read one Bible version, especially if you speak English
- \blacksquare You shall not sing hymns written in our lifetime, especially if you are below 25 \circledcirc

ROMANS 14:2-6

I CORINTHIANS 8:8-13

But meat commendeth us not to God: for neither, if we eat, are we the better; neither, if we eat not, are we the worse.

But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

I CORINTHIANS 8:8-13

... For if any man see thee which hast knowledge sit at meat in the idol's temple, shall not the conscience of him which is weak be emboldened to eat those things which are offered to idols; and through thy knowledge shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died?...

Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.
