I PETER 2:9-3:7

■ Theme

Because Christians are God's chosen people, we must proclaim His praises - by submission.

I PETER 2:9-3:7 (SUBMISSION)

- I. Submission to government authority (2:13-17)
- II. Submission to authority in the workplace (2:18-25)
- III. Submission in marriage wives to husbands, husbands to God's command to love their wives (3:1-7)

... Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. ...
