




How to live stream as a Church family to exalt our Lord

PARTICIPATE


Colossians 3:16 tells us that we are to let 'the word of Christ' dwell in us richly through our speaking and singing in church. Therefore we shouldn't be spectating, but participating actively with a focused mind. Remember to join in to sing! When the word of God is being read and preached, it requires our utmost attention. Let us be ready to receive God's word and let it challenge the way we live!


This means putting away anything that distracts us during the worship service. We shouldn't be multitasking, making coffee or snacking in the midst of the service! This also means not talking and distracting others during the service and especially during the reading and preaching of God's word.

PREPARE

Although we now live stream in the comforts of our own homes, we must still be prepared in our hearts and minds to worship God. We are bowing in reverence to a holy God.

This may mean waking up early and spending time before the service to focus our minds on God and the salvation we have! This also means being on time to log on! The routines that you do every Sunday should carry on even now.





PARTNER

Lastly, Hebrews 10:24-25 reminds us that we are to partner each other in 'stir(ing) one another to love and good works' and 'encouraging one another' to look forward to Jesus' soon return. A great way we can be good partners in the gospel is to push each other to apply the truths that we have heard. We aren't here for information, but for transformation!

This means intentionally discussing the passage that was preached and thinking how it applies to us. This also means spending time in prayer for others and self, helping each other grow and love our Lord more!
